- Giving advice
- Functioning as a central reporting centre
- Judging the following necessary actions
- explore
- Focus on stopping **(child)abuse** and recover and restore safety

What is domestic violence (0 – 100)?

- Perpetrator from the family circle
- Physical, mental and/or sexual
- Relationship between perpetrator and victim
- Dependency relationships

Child abuse

caused by

what parents do or fail to do (educator)

where a child is being harmed

(now and/or later)

Which forms of domestic violence and child abuse (0 – 100)?

- Physical abuse
- Physical neglect
- Mental (emotional) abuse
- Mental (emotional) neglect
- Sexual abuse
- Sexual exploited
- **Witness of domestic violence** (mental (emotional) abuse)

Legislation

- Social Support Act (WMO)
- Reporting Code Act domestic violence and child abuse 2013
- child check
- Law temporary restraining order
- **Sign up right, no reporting obligation**



Signals and risk factors

- Addiction
- Mental deficiency
- debts, unemployment, low educated
- Physical disabled
- Mentally disabled
- Victims and perpetrators of (earlier) domestic violence
- Relationship and divorce issues
- Loneliness, social exclusion and isolation

- Recover / enable safety and optimal development opportunities for child
- Preferably at the own parents
- Only if necessary with the help of child protection
